October 7, 2014 Fire Commission Meeting Minutes

Fire Commissioners:

1. Approval of Agenda-Call to order 730 pm. Approval of Agenda.
 - **M/S. Elsbree/Albano to approve agenda. All in favor.**

2. Approval of September Minutes
 - Commissioner Naylor asked Chief Roach if he had answers for the Commission on particular emergency incidents from the previous Commission Meeting. Chief did not have the details on the incidents from the September Meeting. Commissioner Naylor suggested the Chief take better notes and have the answers in the future. Chief agreed.
 - **M/S Albano/Marinoff to approve September minutes. All In favor.**

3. September Activity Schedule and Response Report.
 - The September Activity Schedule was reviewed. There were no questions.
 - The September Response Report was reviewed. There was a question on calls 733-735 on 9/14. The question was were all three calls at the same address and what were the particulars surrounding the response. Yes, the incidents were all from the same address. An elderly gentleman fell early in the day and only required assistance getting up, and then fell again later in the evening, again only wanting help up. Finally, at night the engine company responded again for head pain and he was transported at that time. There was another question on call number 765 on 9/23 of a child stuck in machinery. The engine company was dispatched to an adolescent who had become stuck in a stairmaster at the YMCA, but the engine was cancelled en route and never made patient contact. Lastly, there was a question on the details of a fence fire in San Rafael Contempo Marin in July at 0310 am from the previous months meeting. It was a small fence fire suspicious in nature that had been extinguished by a neighbor by the time the engine company got there. It appeared that a flammable liquid had been sprayed on the fence and then lit. The investigation was done by San Rafael Police Department.

4. Chief Report
 - Chief gave a status report on the recently signed Shared Services Agreement with San Rafael. Changes have been made in dispatch. Cross over training was completed with emphasis on engine familiarization and drive time, truck training, and SCBA training. Chief has recorded the hours each agency has worked for the other agency and has costs for the Marinwood personnel working in San Rafael. He hopes to meet with Chief Gray within the week to make sure his records are the same and figure out reimbursement.
 - Este Cespedes has passed his paramedic state exam and received his National Registry and State Certification license. Chief Gray is drafting a letter to Miles Julian stating Este Cespedes will be a Marinwood Paramedic working within Paramedic Service Area B under their medical direction. When the EMS office has that Este can take the in county Paramedic Protocol Test. Once that is passed, Este will work a few shifts as a third paramedic on the ambulance to refresh skills and gain experience. San Rafael is assembling ALS bags for Marinwood apparatus. Negotiations need to occur between the Union and the Board to adopt the draft job description and establish salary and benefits for the position as well as an exit strategy for current employees wishing to make the jump to paramedic. Newly hired paramedics will not have that option.

- Chief gave an update on the MERA Campaign he is working on. Priorities for the Committee are public outreach, endorsements, and financial donations.
- Chief gave an update on the lease contract and the engine purchase. CSA 13 cash payment was transferred to KME as well as the lease funded and money transferred to KME. Marinwood CSD first payment on the lease comes next July. Three personnel are flying back to Pennsylvania in late October to meet with KME representatives for a pre construction meeting finalizing the detailed specifications of the engine. KME fully covers the cost of this trip except for the 8 hours of OT paid to the employees who will go off duty.
- Chief reviewed the three strike team assignments noted in the chief's report. He stated that he has only received paperwork back on the first week of the first strike team assignment. Return of that paperwork is followed by reimbursement pay usually within a month.
- The Chief gave an update on a few of the vegetation management projects he is working on around the community, namely a vegetation management and maintenance plan for Rotary Valley, a large pile of dead trees and branches removed from the end of Valleystone, and some vegetation management proposals in LVEHOA area. Ron Marinoff also asked the Chief to supply him with some information on Goats for vegetation management in CSA 13 area that he can take to their Board in October. Chief supplied it to Ron the following day.

COMMUNITY SERVICE/PREVENTION/ASSOCIATION MEETINGS

- I completed six final inspections of new solar systems in Marinwood during October and November.
- One fire commission meeting was held in October.
- I had a meeting in October with the Districts contract maintenance company to get bids for two vegetation management jobs.
- I drove the Type 3 engine in the TLHS Homecoming Parade with the principal of TLHS in October.
- San Rafael Fire Commission held a SRFD Fire Commission meeting at the Marinwood Fire Department during October. Chief Gray asked if they could early in the year to see the Marinwood Fire Station and get a tour.
- The department sponsored one ride to and from school for an auction winner through St. Isabella's School in October.
- A new volunteer orientation was held in October for potential new volunteers.
- A vegetation management project was completed at the end of Valleystone by Treemasters during October.
- Two Vegetation Management projects were completed in LVEHOA area during November by North Bay Conservation Corps.
- Otis Smith and Ryan Bracket taught two CPR Classes to over 40 LVHA residents during October.
- The on duty engine company and I went to Lucas Valley Christian Pre-school for a fire safety talk and showing of equipment during October.
- I attended multiple MERA campaign strategy meetings during October-Measure passed in November!
- The on duty engine company went to Bright Horizons Pre-school for a fire safety talk and showing of equipment during October.
- The on duty engine company and I attended the Lucas Valley Homeowners Association Day and taught fire extinguisher use and a Get Ready Class to over 40 residents.
- The on duty engine company and I taught a kindergarten fire safety class to four different kindergarten classes at Mary Silveira School in November.
- I attended the Marin County Fire Chief's Planning Meeting for 2015 in November.
- The on duty engine company gave a tour to Montessori Middle School and had a discussion with them about a career in the fire service.

TRAINING

- Six minutes of Safety training was reviewed daily by on duty staff.
- Este Cespedes continues to work on his paramedic skills but negotiations need to take place to finalize the position of Paramedic in Marinwood. See Chief Report for more.

- Department Personnel continued with the Target Safety Training Program October and November.
- One paid employee continued working on Officer Training.
- All three shifts participated in a multi company drill/training through the Central Marin Training Consortium in October and November. Hazardous Materials class room and decontamination drill were the topics for the month. Marinwood Fire Department personnel provided the instruction to all Central Marin Training Consortium members.
- Eight volunteer drills were held in October and November. Topics included Hazardous Materials training, decontamination training, firefighter safety and survival, pump operations, and structural firefighting training.
- All full time department personnel had a flu shot administered during November.

MAINTENANCE

- All 4 department vehicles underwent a comprehensive monthly check during October and November.
- All gas-powered equipment was checked weekly during the month.
- All vehicle batteries were serviced and charged on a weekly basis during the month.
- All radio batteries were rotated and charged on a weekly basis during the month.
- Engine 58 had a preventative maintenance check done in November.
- Unit 58 had a preventative maintenance check done in November.

Paramedic Update through Shared Services

Firefighter Este Cespedes has passed his state paramedic certification. He received his National Registry and his California State certification. Chief Gray has drafted a letter to County EMS Agency that allows for Este to work as a paramedic within Paramedic Service Area B. Este has been cleared to take the Marin County EMS Protocol Test. San Rafael has assembled ALS bags for Marinwood apparatus.

Salary and benefits for the position need to be negotiated as well as an exit strategy for current Marinwood employees who wish to voluntarily move to a firefighter paramedic position. A draft Paramedic job description has been created and also needs to be discussed with the labor group. A letter has been sent from Tom Horne to the Marinwood Shop Steward asking to meet and confer about the Paramedic Position. A reply was received from the Union asking to wait until January to meet regarding the paramedic position so they could focus on the regular negotiations which hopefully will be completed by then.

MERA Update

MERA Passed. A little over 67%. This is good for the CSD budget. Had it failed, as early as next budget year the District's MERA costs could have escalated to 230% of what it currently is, an increase of about \$40,000 a year.

Vegetation Management Projects

The vegetation Management Project at the end of Valleystone Drive has been completed by Treemasters. They did a great job. North Bay Conservation Corps completed two project areas in the Lucas Valley Estates Homeowners Association Area. They also did a great job.

CPR Class Lucas Valley Homeowners Association

Otis Smith and Ryan Bracket taught two CPR Classes on Saturday September 18 to over 40 residents. The class were very well attended and very well received.

Safety Day at Lucas Valley Homeowners Association

The On Duty Shift and I participated in a Safety Day at Lucas Valley Homeowners Association during November. The Fire Department taught Fire Extinguisher use and had hands on training available for those interested. Ryan Bracket also taught a Get Ready Class to residents. Disaster Preparedness kits were sold, supply lists provided, and fire extinguisher servicing were also all available.

Mary Silveira Kindergarten Fire Safety Day

During November the on duty engine company and I taught a fire safety class to the four different kindergarten classes at Silveira School, over 80 students. How fire safety as well as a show and tell with the fire engine were included.

District Manager Update

The Board retained CPS Human Resources to help with a search for District Manager. The job description was updated and the position advertised in numerous locations. CPS received close to 30 applications for the position. CPS screened those applications down to 11 for the Board of Directors to review. From the application review, six were picked to be interviewed. There were two interview panels of six people. Each panel had a board member, a chair of one of the Commissions, one department head, two Community appointees, and General Manager of another CSD. Applicants were interviewed by both panels. At the end of all the interviews the candidates were ranked. The top four went to a Board interview. Currently the Board is in negotiations with the top candidate for the position.
