May 2, 2017 Fire Commission Meeting Minutes **DRAFT**

1. Approval of Agenda-Call to order 7:00 pm.

• M/S Curran/Elsbree to approve agenda as presented. All in favor.

2. Public Comments on Non Agenda Items

- Linda Barnello commented on the NextDoor post and IJ article about SRFF Este
 Cespedes picture and story on him training on new fire boat and saving two lost dogs
 while they were training.
- 3. Draft Minutes for the April Commission Meeting
 - M/S Curran/Marinoff to approve the April Minutes. Commissioner Marinoff
 commented that in the April Meeting when budget was being discussed he felt CSA
 13 should not have to contribute towards Attorney Fees. Attorney fees line item is
 up to \$45,000 for Labor negotiations and FLSA lawsuit. All in favor as ammended.
- 4. Activity Summary and Response Report for April 2017.
 - The Activity Summary for April 2017 was reviewed. Chief commented that Marinwood was responsible for delivering the CMTC Block Training for Marinwood, San Rafael, Corte Madera, Larkspur, and Kentfield, again. New Captains Brackett and Selvitella lead the training but everyone helped out. This training was in preparation for wildland season.
 - The Response Report for April 2017 was reviewed. Dan Curran referenced an
 emergency response to his house for his wife and commented on how courteous and
 professional the crew was. Commissioner Russ Albano had a question about all of the
 "Difficulty Breathing" emergencies and was wondering if any of the calls were for the
 same person. Chief did not have that info but said he would follow up and report back.
- 5. Fire Department Budget 2017/18
 - The draft budget for 17/18 and actuals for 16/17 were reviewed as well as both for the
 District as a whole. There were no questions. Chief did comment that he was hoping to
 have the awards and recognitions line item restored to the full amount of \$3,000 from it's
 current \$1,500. Greg Stilson commented that the dinner was always very well received
 by the volunteer firefighters.
- 6. Chief Report and Engineer's
 - Chief gave an update on the Disaster Preparedness Trailer. It has been completely
 outfitted and map books prepared. Chief is planning on taking to some CERT Block
 Parties and on display at Pancake Breakfast.
 - Chief gave an update on the upcoming Engineer's Promotional Process and the Job
 Announcement was reviewed. There are two in house candidates qualified and certified
 to take the exam for one position. Written, practical, and interviews will all be completed
 by June 15 with a promotion soon to follow.
 - Chief gave an update on preparations for Wildland Season. All hose will be tested in May, wildland packs placed in service, and wildland training emphasized.

Chief gave an update on two vegetation management projects he is working on. One here
in Marinwood with CCNB doing the work and one in CSA 13 that Kelby Jones (CSA 13
Disaster Prep Coordinator) is organizing.

7. Kitchen Remodel

- Chief had received three bids from Architects for drawings for the new kitchen.
 Drawings/plans are needed to go with the RFP and eventually to be submitted to
 County for permits. One bid was more than half the cost of the other two and the Chief entered into a contract with that architect.
- 8. Succession Planning for the Implementation of Paramedics
 - Chief gave an update on the paramedics in the department. Dan Rotwein and Sean Day, both paramedics are on different shifts, certified and qualified as Paramedics in Marin County, but are currently serving as EMT's. Chief has a current eligibility list, and with Captain White's pending retirement another will be hired soon. Chief is hoping to coordinate the new hire with San Rafael's next academy.

Relief Firefighter Position-Vacant

One Fire Captain off on industrial disability leave. I have hired David Purcell, a volunteer Firefighter who meets the Firefighter requirements as a temporary firefighter beginning in June. Shifts were rebid after the Engineer promotion. Above shifts reflect the new line up. I have a current firefighter paramedic list and will hire at least one, possibly two depending on Captain Heine's status when the next new hire academy occurs. This could be September or October, exact dates TBD.

VOLUNTEER STAFFING

20 Current Volunteers including:

One Volunteer Battalion Chief

1 Volunteer Firefighter/AO's

7 Volunteer Firefighters qualified as "responders" (includes AO's & BC)

A volunteer Engineer Academy is being put on by newly promoted Engineer Jeff Smith. There are 5 volunteers in the program.

EMERGENCY CALLS

In June and July 2017 the department responded to 200 emergency calls that were mostly medical in nature. The department did respond to a vehicle fire in Marinwood, a vehicle fire in CSA 13, two vegetation fires in Novato, and one structure fire in Novato.

COMMUNITY SERVICE/PREVENTION/ASSOCIATION MEETINGS

 I completed eight final inspection of new solar systems in Marinwood during June and July.

- One final residential sprinkler inspection was completed in Marinwood in June and four rough in sprinkler inspection were completed in June and July.
- One Board Meeting was held in June and July.
- I, along with help from four volunteers, continue to work on the disaster preparedness trailer in June. The trailer is complete!
- I continued working with the Lions Club and the CERT Steering Committee on CERT related issues in June and July. Two CERT Steering committee meetings were held in June.
- I attended the MERA Governing Board and Executive Board meetings in June and July.
- The on duty engine company made 2 stops at a birthday parties during June and July.
- Two volunteers and I took the Type 3 to a birthday party in Terra Linda in June.
- I attended the Old Dixie Schoolhouse Foundation Board meeting in June and am now the Board President.
- I walked the wildland interface of CSA 13 with their Emergency Preparedness Coordinator to review a vegetation management project during June. The project was completed in July.
- I sent out information on vegetation management through next door, neighberries, the CSD website and facebook, and the District email list.
- I attended Superintendant Tom Lowasser's Retirement Party. He is retiring after serving the Dixie School District for over 30 years.
- A vegetation management project in the Open Space behind Ironstone Court homes was completed in June.
- Two camp tours were done at the firehouse during June.
- The Pancake Breakfast was held on July Fourth at the Park.
- I was interviewed by Conservation Corps North Bay on how the Fire Department interacts with CCNB and how the relationship could be improved.
- I took the CRET Trailer to a Block Party in Marinwood during July and promoted CERT in Marinwood.

TRAINING

- Six minutes of Safety training was reviewed daily by on duty staff.
- Department Personnel continued with the Target Safety Training Program during June and July.
- All three shifts went through multi company drill in June for wildland hose evolutions. SRFD Boat Orientation Training was comleted by all personnel during July.
- The on duty engine company taught fire suppression, fire extinguisher use, and SCBA use to a sheriff academy class in June.

- Marinwood delivered the CMTC Block Training of Wildland Safety during May and June. Captain's Brackett and Selvitella and Acting Captain Papanikolaou delivered the training.
- The on duty engine company attended a Chemical Spill drill at the YMCA in June.
- Eight Volunteer drills were held in June and July. Topics included preparing for responder testing, wildland operations, and preparing for the pancake breakfast.
- Dan continues to work on his Probationary Training.
- Jeff Smith had his Engineer's Interview during June.
- Jeff Smith was promoted to Engineer in June.

MAINTENANCE

- All 4 department vehicles underwent a comprehensive monthly check during June.
- All gas-powered equipment was checked weekly during the month.
- All vehicle batteries were serviced and charged on a weekly basis during the month.
- All hose was tested during May and June as well as wildland packs prepared and placed in service on the engines.
- Kitchen remodel continues. More in the Chief's report on that.
- In July, I toured the Fire Road damage from last winter's storms with FEMA reps in the hopes of receiving reimbursement money for repairs.
- In July, I toured the Fire Road damage with members from MCFD who will be performing the repairs during.

Management, Kitchen Remodel, Succession Planning for the Marinwood FD

Succession Planning for implementation of Paramedic Positions

The department currently has two paramedics, one on A shift (Dan Rotwein) and one on C Shift (Sean Day). There is one immediate opening (Joel White's retirement) and one long term opening, possibly turning to a full time opening depending on what happens with his disability (Captain Steve Heine). I have hired Volunteer David Purcell as a Temp Firefighter to temporarily help fill the gap. The department has an eligibility list of Firefighter Paramedics. When the next new hire academy happens Marinwood will have one new hire, possibly two depending on what happens with Captain Heine's injury. San Rafael is not having a new hire academy until early fall at the soonest.

Some possible hiring scenarios, of course some of this depends on Captain Heine's situation. At the very least all of these options include having a third paramedic on shift-

- A. Hire two firefighter paramedics from the eligibility list place them both through the new hire academy and put one on shift and one as the relief guy.
- B. Hire one off the eligibility list place him through the new hire academy and continue using temps to fill the relief firefighter position.
- C. Hire one off the eligibility list and send through the new hire academy and place on shift. This gives the department three paramedics, one on each shift. And promote temporary hire David Purcell to the full time relief firefighter position. David meets all of the requirements of the firefighter job description, has been a volunteer for three years and starts paramedic school in early August. Having him on the relief schedule will allow for some flexibility with his schedule so he can attend classes. Plus it's great for the volunteer program to hire someone from the ranks. And San Rafael will only reimburse the department for three paramedics anyway and the department will have one on each shift.

I recommend going with option C.

Cert Trailer Project

The trailer is complete and is an available resource to the Marinwood CERT Team or others in and around the County should they need it.

Wildland Season and Vegetation Management Projects

Wildland Season is upon California and Marin. The department's Type 3 is prepared and ready and wildland packs have been added to the Type 1 also.

Two vegetation Management projects have been completed, the CSA 13 interface fire break with the help of Ron Marinoff, Kelby Jones, and Treemasters. Also, a project was

completed in the Marinwood Open Space behind homes on Ironstone court. The work was completed by Conservation Corps North Bay.

Kitchen Remodel

The plans have been completed and I received a bid from a DIR Registered contractor from Fairfax, John Pope Construction. His initial bid was high, but I met with him and explained the kitchen budget was at the most \$65,000. He is revamping his bid and explained that by sub contracting out some of the work there can be considerable savings. I am waiting for his new proposal. If it comes back with in budget I recommend the District move forward with that company to complete the kitchen project.

Succession Planning for the Marinwood Fire Department

I suggest putting together a working group to study the future and sustainability of the Marinwood Fire Department. Increasing costs and future retirements make this a good time to begin the process. There are many possibilities including but limited to possible restructuring, consolidations, reverse contracts for service to name a few. How these different options affect; the community, the delivery of service, the level of service, the employees, sustainability, and cost should all be considered.
