



## **NOTICE OF COMMITTEE SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES**

**Marinwood Community Services District is currently accepting letters of interest to serve on the Marinwood Emergency Services Succession Committee.**

The time has come for an in depth study of how best to deliver financially sustainable Emergency Services to District residents. While the District's current safety service is operationally top notch, the costs of maintaining an independent Emergency Services department are trending in a financially unsustainable direction without significant changes or revenue increases.

The Emergency Services Succession Committee, serving as a temporary advisory body to the Board of Directors, will investigate options and present findings while working towards the goal of creating a formal recommendation on how best to provide emergency services. This includes analyzing operational, financial, personnel and legal aspects of various emergency services delivery options. There will be a great deal of research, analysis and presentations until a final set of recommendations is made to the Board of Directors.

The Committee is comprised of nine (9) total members, primarily those who work for or serve the District in some capacity. Appointing members of the public to serve as official members of the Committee is of critical importance and benefit to the Committee, District and most importantly the community.

As such, there are two open positions available for appointment designated for members of the public:

- 1. One District Resident** (Must reside within Marinwood/Lucas Valley Estates)
- 2. One At-Large member**

The Committee will conduct regular meetings on the first Tuesday of each month at 5:30PM at the Marinwood Community Center. The first meeting will be conducted on Tuesday, October 3, 2017. Meetings are open and all interested members of the public are welcome and encouraged to attend.
