December 6, 2016 Fire Commission Meeting Minutes

Fire Chief Tom Roach, Board Member Izabela Perry, District Manager Eric Dreikosen, Potential Fire Commissioner Pascal

There was no quorum for the first 45 minutes of the meeting. The first part of the unofficial meeting all present introduced themselves to a prospective fire commissioner, we talked a bit about the role of the fire commission, and he introduced himself. After that Izabela gave a 10 minute presentation on the new website and some discussion followed. Ron Marinoff arrived at 745 pm which allowed the meeting to be called to order and an abbreviated meeting was held.

1. Approval of Agenda-Call to order 7:45 pm.
  - **M/S Marinoff/Curran to approve adjusted agenda. All in favor.**
2. Chief Report and Grant Update
  - Chief gave a report on the Assistance to Firefighter Grant. All the SCBA's and related equipment have been placed in service and paid for. Follow up reports by the Chief will be maintained over the one year period of performance. Also the 2017 AFG was submitted for a new utility vehicle.
  - Chief gave an update on the Disaster Preparedness Trailer. Work has begun on the outfitting the inside of the trailer with necessary disaster supplies. Four volunteer firefighters are assisting the Chief with the project.
3. Succession Planning for the Implementation of Paramedics
  - Chief gave an update on the Captain's promotional testing process.
  - Chief gave an update on the Paramedic testing process and the eligibility list.
  - Discussion followed as to hire 1 or 2 new paramedics for the new hire academy. **M/S Curran/Albano to hire one full time paramedic and hire a second paramedic as a temporary hire.** Send both through the new hire academy and then put them on the staff. The understanding being that should both workers compensation injuries return to duty the second temp hire will be let go until such a time as there is another opening. At the conclusion of 1000 hours the Board will consider hiring the second paramedic to full time status.
  - Dan Curran, Russ Albano, and Tom Elsbree would all like to be reappointed to the Fire Commission.
  - Ron Marinoff has been taken the position of Vice Chair on the Commission.

### **EMERGENCY CALLS**

### **COMMUNITY SERVICE/PREVENTION/ASSOCIATION MEETINGS**

- I completed three final inspections of new solar systems in Marinwood and CSA 13 during January.
- Two final remodel inspections were completed in Marinwood in January.

- One Board Meeting was held in January.
- I, along with help from four volunteers, continue to work on the disaster preparedness trailer in January
- One fundraising ride to school was completed in January.
- I completed additional reporting and documentation for the SCBA Grant in January.
- I continued working with the Lions Club on CERT related issues, including mapping and radio protocol in January. Multiple meetings were held with a mapping contractor and the CERT Maps are just about complete.
- I provided construction and development feedback to the County for the Oaks Development in January.
- I met with the demolition company supervisor about the sprinkler system in Hoytt Plaza.
- A girl scout tour and first aid talk was held at the firehouse in January.

### **TRAINING**

- Six minutes of Safety training was reviewed daily by on duty staff.
- Department Personnel continued with the Target Safety Training Program during January.
- All three shifts went through multi company drill in January.
- Marinwood is responsible for delivering the CMTC Block Training of Auto Extrication in February and March. Captain's Brackett and Selvitella are the lead instructors.
- Four Volunteer drills were held in January. Topics included new volunteer orientation, hose lines aloft and auto extrication.
- Four new Volunteer Firefighters were hired in December and began their orientation.
- I held Chief interviews for new Firefighter Paramedic hires, two were offered jobs, one full time, one temporary.
- The Captain's Assessment center was completed in December over two days.

### **MAINTENANCE**

- All 4 department vehicles underwent a comprehensive monthly check during January..
- All gas-powered equipment was checked weekly during the month.
- All vehicle batteries were serviced and charged on a weekly basis during the month.
- Storm preparation was done during January. All storm related equipment was prepared as well as working with the parks department to prepare the community in January.

### **Draft Fire Department Budget 2017/18**

Eric and I are working on the budget. It is being developed through Quickbooks this year and is a little different and not quite ready for Commission review. First half of the year actuals are being put together and will be available by the Board Meeting next week.

### **Assistance to Firefighter Grant**

I continue to manage the 2016 AFG with mid year reporting requirements being done during January. The SCBA's have all been purchased and are working well. A 2017 AFG was submitted for a new Utility Pick Up Truck.

### **Cert Trailer Project**

I continue to work with four volunteers to equip the trailer with all necessary supplies. Hope to have it completed by the end of the year. All of the medical supplies have been ordered. When they arrive Volunteer Firefighter Paramedic Brian Jones is going to arrange four individual caches of many supplies that can be transported to different locations around the community for first aid stations. Next step is to purchase emergency lighting, heavy duty electrical cords, pop up awnings for some shelter from weather, folding table and chairs, ICS Paperwork, and eventually maps. The mapping is very close to being completed.

### **Fire Department Goals for 2017**

Some of the goals I am hoping for the department to accomplish during 2017 are-

- \*Hold an Engineer's Promotional Exam Process in the first half of the year.
- \*Implement Paramedic Service and establish an ALS Engine Company
- \*Replace the Utility Pick Up Truck
- \*Continue working with Marinwood CERT and the Lions Club on Disaster Preparedness in Marinwood
- \*Continue to maintain the Volunteer Firefighter Program and hold an in house Volunteer Engineer Training Program
- \*Sign an expanded Shared Services Agreement which would include Marinwood, San Rafael, Larkspur, Corte Madera, and Kentfield, all CMTC Departments.
- \*This of course is not an all inclusive list just some of the highlights.

If there are any additional things you would like the Department to accomplish we can discuss at the Commission Meeting.

**Succession Planning for implementation of Paramedic Positions**

The department currently has one paramedics on a 24 hour shift. He is current and licensed in Marin County as a Paramedic. He attends on going paramedic trainings and CQI study sessions with San Rafael FD.

Volunteer Firefighter and Paramedic Daniel Rotwein was hired effective January 6, 2017. He begins the new hire academy on January 9, 2017.

Firefighter Paramedic Dean Barsocchini was hired a Temporary Firefighter effective January 6, 2017. He also begins the new hire academy on January 9, 2017.

The new hire academy ends February 18, both will be placed on shift depending on the outcome or status of the long term injuries. That's three paramedics in the department.
