*SMALL backpacks/bags will be allowed into the park area, however please limit belongings as the bags are searched at the gate and will delay entrance into the park. Please have children come dressed in their swim suits to save time when we arrive. All bags will be searched prior to entry.

Lunch:

Lunch will be provided inside the park. A cheeseburger, potato chips, apples, ice cream and drink is included. If you prefer a vegetarian meal, you must tell the Camp Director on the Monday (first day) of the session. Vegetarian lunches include Boca Burgers, chips, ice cream and a drink.

NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK.

At the Field Trip Location:

Groups will stay together throughout the day with no campers allowed to go anywhere unsupervised. There will be a “no ride” group, “some rides” group, and an “all ride” group. Campers will be grouped according to size and ride interests with two counselors to each group. Only swimwear is allowed on the waterslides although swim shirts for preventing sunburn are permitted. Cutoffs, clothing with rivets, buckles, and jewelry are not permitted. Watersocks and sandals are permitted throughout the park although campers may be asked to hold them on select slides. Glasses are not permitted in the Breaker Beach wavepool and the waterslides. There are many other attractions available for campers who must wear eyeglasses. Certain slides have height minimums of 36”, 42”, 48” and/or weight restrictions. It would be helpful to inform your child of his/her height in inches and weight.

Other Information:

Please note that any children who misbehave on a field trip will be required to sit out of the activities. If behavior is repetitive or severe, you will be asked to pick up your child at the field trip location.

The Camp Supervisor will be attending the field trip.

Please note that there is no alternate activity on field trip days for those not attending. All travel to and from the field trip destinations is to be done as part of the group with our camp staff and United Coach Tours buses.
