Since its establishment 60 years ago, the Marinwood Community Services District has expanded and improved each of the services which have become part of all our lives. In that time, the health and safety of our community has always been the District's primary objective.

The current pandemic has prompted dramatic and painful changes for us all. District management and staff have acted aggressively to anticipate as well as follow the recommendations of the Marin County Health and Human Services department in cancelling scheduled events, closing the community center and park facilities in the effort to protect the health of all community members.

As this crisis evolves it is uncertain how long we will need to shelter in place or when, and to what extent, we can safely reinstate the programs and perhaps events which make our community the wonderful place it is.

In the meantime, know that the District's staff is still at work.

Management staff is working primarily online on both financial and contingency planning efforts as well as responding to inquiries. The staff rotates a visit to work at the Community Center and ensures that the center remains sanitized while it is closed.

The Fire Department is fully staffed and responding normally. Even more than usual we salute their heroism during this extraordinary period.

Park Staff rotates daily visits to the parks to ensure that trash receptacles and animal waste collection points are maintained as well as performing security checks on park facilities.

Recreation Staff is keeping in touch with seasonal staff and communicating frequently with County officials on what restrictions need to be in place.

On my daily walks in the park I see several community members out in the park, practicing social distancing. Until we can safely reopen our park facilities and programs, we hope that you will continue to enjoy a pleasant walk in our parks keeping the 6-foot social distancing in mind.

It is our hope that as the summer season approaches that we will be able to resume our suspended programs and services. We will do so only when we can be confident that we can meet our primary objective of protecting the health and safety of our community members.
