



Upon receipt of your registration form and payment, you will be registered for the class unless notified that a class is full or cancelled, in which case a full refund will be granted. Please note: Marinwood CSD only allows one payer per receipt.

Classes and Camps Refund and Transfer Policy:

Minimum cancellation fee: \$10.00. (Cancellation fee may vary, check registration activity on website for details). All refunds and changes must be made in writing and can be emailed to csd@marinwood.org. We will not process refunds or changes over the phone. Marinwood CSD reserves the right to cancel any class/activity that does not meet minimum enrollment. Please register early to avoid class cancellations. If a class is cancelled, you will receive a full refund.

Director's Letter

Summer's end is always a bittersweet time for us in the Rec Department—a time to celebrate completing another crazy summer camp season, but also a somber time of goodbyes as our beloved seasonal employees head back to school, some of whom will regrettably not be returning next summer. This year's goodbyes, however, have been especially difficult as we bid farewell not only to our seasonal staff but also to our Recreation Supervisor—and good friend—John Paul Kessler as he moves to Massachusetts to sow his wild oats and seek his fortune.

John Paul's departure signifies much more to me than just the end of his tenure at Marinwood—it feels like the end of an era. John Paul has worked on and off for the District since 2007—two years before I was hired to run the pool. He was one of the first lifeguards I met that season and we immediately hit it off. Though he looked the part of a laidback skater kid—perpetually barefoot, hair



in an unkempt mop, skateboard always by his side—he nevertheless impressed me with his deft lifeguarding skills, his friendly and easygoing demeanor, and his palpable love for the pool and Marinwood in general. After that initial meeting, I remember feeling encouraged that I was going to get along well with my new lifeguard staff. But I never could have predicted that I would still be working with John Paul 13 years later.

After graduating high school John Paul didn't immediately head off to college but instead worked at Marinwood as much as possible (every pool manager's dream come true!), saving up while he figured out what he wanted to do next. We lifeguarded together a lot those next couple seasons and began forging a deep friendship. I learned that John Paul was a deep thinker, an aspiring handyman, a voracious reader, and a huge fan of music. We would often spend our lifeguard shifts musing on the meaning of life, recommending bands to each other, and attempting to make DIY repairs to various equipment around the pool. Those seasons were an absolute blast and hold some of my fondest memories at Marinwood.

Through the years John Paul rose the ranks becoming a Senior Lifeguard, Swim Instructor, and eventually running the show as Marinwood's Head Lifeguard, also teaching Lifeguard Training and CPR courses on the side. He eventually moved away to pursue other endeavors but always stayed in touch and was willing to return from time to time to help teach a lifeguarding class or fill in as a building attendant. (One winter he even did a short stint working on our Parks Maintenance Staff when we were shorthanded!) I think John Paul easily holds the record for most job titles held with the District, an achievement of which he is extremely proud. All of this is a testament to John Paul's deep love for Marinwood—something I have always greatly admired and often benefited from.

John Paul's latest (and most likely final) stint with the District was as our Recreation Supervisor this past 2 years. In this role John Paul completed the progression he started over 15 years ago, now managing the pool that hired him, and now hiring, training, and mentoring the next generation of Marinwood lifeguards. John Paul flourished in this role, building a tight camaraderie with his staff and keeping the pool running smoothly. The mop-topped skater kid I met back in 2009 had now become a long-haired, long-bearded full-grown man, though still perpetually barefoot and sometimes still arriving by skateboard.

John Paul was a wonderful addition to our full-time recreation staff. We will miss his creativity, his humor, and his unceasing positivity. But most of all, we will miss seeing our friend every day. Getting to work with John Paul has been one of the greatest pleasures of my career and I will be forever grateful to him for helping make Marinwood such an enjoyable place to work. We wish him all the best.
