PAYMENT:

Payment must be received at the time of registration along with a registration form. We gladly accept Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover, cash, or check (made out to MCSD).

Upon receipt of your registration form and payment, you will be registered for the class unless notified that a class is full or cancelled, in which case a full refund will be granted. Please note: Marinwood CSD only allows one payer per receipt.

CLASSES AND CAMPS REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY:

Minimum cancellation fee: \$10.00. (Cancellation fee may vary, check registration activity on website for details). All refunds and changes must be made in writing and can be emailed to csd@marinwood.org. We will not process refunds or changes over the phone. Marinwood CSD reserves the right to cancel any class/activity that does not meet minimum enrollment. Please register early to avoid class cancellations. If a class is cancelled, you will receive a full refund.

GOVERNANCE

The Marinwood Community Services District (CSD) was formed in 1960 to provide street lighting, fire protection and park and recreation services for our area. The CSD is governed by an elected five-member Board of Directors. The Board has established two advisory Commissions (Fire and Parks and Recreation) to oversee the routine operations of the District and to make recommendations regarding policies and budgetary matters. The District Manager and Department Heads carry out the day-to-day functions of the District as directed by the Board. The Board and Commission agendas can be found at www.marinwood.org. The Marinwood Review provides information on community meetings, events, programs, and other information of interest to the Community. Comments or suggestions regarding the publication should be directed to csd@marinwood.org.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors is a 5-member governing body of the Marinwood Community Services District (MCSD) and acts collectively to establish policies, provide oversight, and set vision to ensure the District offers the highest level of service in a fiscally sustainable way.

The Board of Directors has authority to establish or modify ordinances, resolutions and policies guiding the governance and operation of MCSD within its geographical boundaries and sphere of influence, including Joint Powers and Shared Services Agreements. The Board of Directors provides direction to and receives recommendations from the District Manager, the Fire Commission and the Park & Recreation Commission. The primary responsibility of the Board of Directors is the formulation and evaluation of policy. Routine matters concerning the operational aspects of the District are to be delegated to professional staff members of the District.

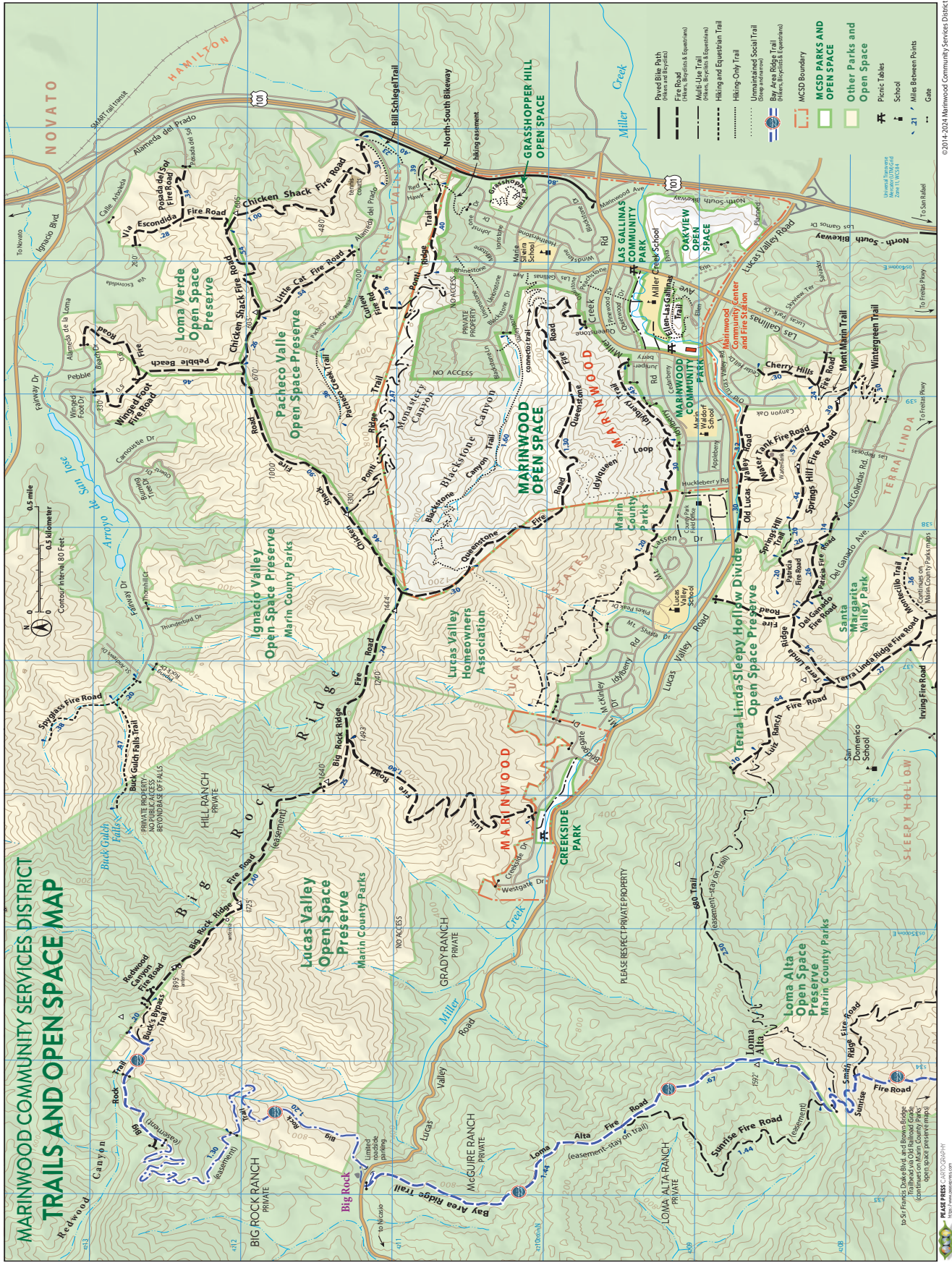

Trash Talk

Greetings, folks! And welcome to another issue of the Marinwood Review, North America's most prestigious Marinwood CSD-focused recreation publication. In the following pages you will find information about the Marinwood Recreation programs, classes, and community events being offered this fall, as well as some advertisements from reputable local businesses and other miscellaneous filler (because it's hard to hit the page count just right when working with 8-page increments!). See if you can spot the filler. If you're still reading this you're getting warmer...

Just kidding. I am fully aware that the Welcome Letter is the antithesis of "filler." It's the very lynchpin of this publication. The cornerstone. The beating heart, without which the rest of these pages would lose all meaning and context, and you would just rip them out and throw them on the ground.

But please don't do that. Because there is already plenty of trash on the ground.

Yes, keeping things clean is one of the many challenges of operating a summer camp program that brings 500+ kids into the park each day. That's 500 snacks, 500 lunches, 500 arts & crafts projects, 500 wristbands, and 500 backpacks in various stages of unzip. When you also consider the infamous Marinwood wind, the ever-present scavenging crows, and the steady, all-day shuffling of kids from point A to point B, it is unsurprising that the grass sometimes looks a little "accessorized" by the end of the day. A few shiny candy wrappers here, some colorful friendship bracelets and lanyards there, and always a lonely sock.

We used to talk a lot about the trash. How can we limit our waste? Where's the optimal placement of trash cans? Who should we schedule for trash cleanup? Lots of emails. Lots of meetings. Lots of "trash talk." And this has resulted in a lot of progress and a much cleaner park. But a wise friend of mine, who spends his free time volunteering to clean up beaches and rivers and parks, and who has the world's most impressive collection of litter removal devices, encouraged me that sometimes we should do less trash talking and more trash walking. In other words, just go pick it up.

So we're trying to walk the walk, literally (is that a pun?). We have recently institutionalized the EODPCTW, or End-Of-Day-Post-Camp-Trash-Walk. The name could use some work, but it's become one of the highlights of my day. Just a simple walk through the park after the camps leave to pick up the odds and ends left behind. It's a chance to stretch our legs and debrief about the day, a chance to see which camps kept their spots the cleanest, and it allows us to leave for the day knowing we left the park in good condition. And the EODPCTW has spilled over into the other parts of the day where now any walk through the park, or anywhere else, often becomes another miniature trash walk.

It turns out that picking up trash is not just good for the park, it's also good for the soul. It's tactile and tangible. It's a small but real way to genuinely improve our surroundings in real time. It also sets a good example for the young people in our midst and builds camaraderie, showing that we're all in this "cleanup cause" together and no task is beneath any of us. It's a small, low-stakes act of community service that doesn't need scheduling, meetings, strategies, equipment or budgets. You just do it and it's done, which is oddly satisfying. It's also extremely addictive, which is great because there's always more trash to pick up.

I hope you'll find something in our catalog that meets your needs—a class to enroll in or an event to attend. But at the very least, we hope to see you in the park. And if you see any trash...

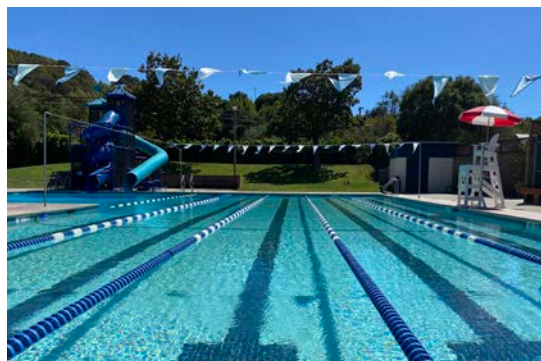

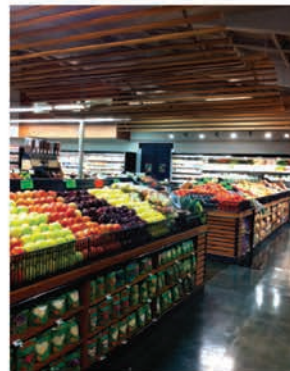
