

#### Policies

All registrations are on a first come, first served basis.

#### Payment:

Payment must be received at the time of registration along with a registration form. We gladly accept Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover, cash, or check (made out to MCSD). Upon receipt of your registration form and payment, you will be

registered for the class unless notified that a class is full or cancelled, in which case a full refund will be granted. Please note: Marinwood CSD only allows one payer per receipt.

#### Classes and Camps Refund and Transfer Policy:

All refunds and changes must be made in writing and can be emailed to csd@marinwood.org. We will not process refunds or changes over the phone. Marinwood CSD reserves the right to cancel any class/activity that does not meet minimum enrollment. Please register early to avoid class cancellations. If a class is cancelled, you will receive a full refund.

Refunds are class specific, please see activity details for policy.

#### Summer Camps:

All refund and change requests must be made in writing and can be emailed to csd@marinwood.org. We will not process refunds or changes over the phone. Cancellations made more than 6 business days prior to the beginning of the camp session will result in a \$35 per session per camper fee. Cancellations made less than 6 business days prior to the beginning of the camp session will result in the forfeiture of half the camp session fee per camper. No refunds will be granted after 5:00pm the Friday before the camp session begins. All camp change requests must be made in writing and are subject to a \$10 handling fee. The Marinwood Community Services District (CSD) was formed in 1960 to provide street lighting, fire protection and park and recreation services for our area. 

Recent past and current service projects include some of the following:

- Tutoring First Graders Volunteers tutor ESL students at a San Rafael elementary school in reading and vocabulary comprehension. Volunteers read for 30 minutes once a week with one student over several months using an online reading program linked to ZOOM.
- Letter Campaign for People with Disabilities Succeeding Program- Volunteers are assigned to a person with disabilities and write weekly to them. These individuals are more isolated now due to the pandemic and receiving weekly note can be a great morale booster.
- Music for Isolated Seniors- Over the summer, CD players and CDs were donated to Marin Post Acute for patients to enjoy music in their rooms when isolated.
- "Feeding Marin Families"- An effort to raise over \$20,000 in donations for the SF-Marin Food Bank by the Lions clubs of Marin. Las Gallinas Lions will match up to \$3,000 in member donations. Donate through the Las Gallinas Lions Facebok page!
- Community Informational Flyer-We assembled, printed, and delivered over 5,000 flyers to the local community detailing available resources during the COVID crisis.
- Speaker Series- We host monthly informational presentations by community and nonprofit leaders. Past speakers have included Marin Search & Rescue, Marin County Supervisor (Lion) Damon Connolly, Miller Creek MS and Laurel Del Elementary teachers reporting on adaptive teaching under the pandemic and CEO of Play Marin, a non-profit based in Marin City.

#### How do I register my child for camp?

There are three ways to register:

-Online registration at www.marinwood.org. (Recommended—typically the fastest registration method)

-Register in person at the Community Center

-Mail, fax or scan and email a registration form (complete with full payment).

#### What if the camp I want to register for is full already?

If a camp is full, you may place your camper on a waiting list through the Marinwood website. You will not be charged if placed on the waiting list. Our staff will contact you if a spot becomes available and you will have 24 hours to get back to us. After July 1, Marinwood will be disabling wait lists and camp openings will be first come, first served.

#### Can I drop in for a day of camp?

No, Marinwood will not be accepting drop-in registrations. Campers must be registered for the full session.

#### Interested in sponsoring a fellow camp family?

Please consider donating to our scholarship fund to help send a child to camp. Donate online or at the Community Center.

#### Do you offer sibling or other discounts?

Yes, we offer discounts for siblings and pool members.

- Sibling Discount: \$20 off per session for each additional child you enroll. The discount only applies if registering siblings for the same camp session.
- Pool Member Discount: \$20 off per session. Camper must have an individual pool membership or be listed on a family or couple membership for the 2022 season. Please see page 44 for how to join the pool. Please note: Discounts only applicable if membership is purchased prior to camp registration.

#### Do you offer camp scholarships or financial aid?

Yes, a limited number of partial camp scholarships are available based on financial need. All requests are kept strictly confidential. An application can be downloaded from our website at www.marinwood.org. Only complete applications will be reviewed.

#### What is your refund policy? How do I make camp changes?

All refund and change requests must be made in writing and can be emailed to csd@marinwood.org. We will not process refunds or changes over the phone. Cancellations made more than 6 business days prior to the beginning of the camp session will result in a \$35 per session per camper fee.

### What is your refund policy? How do I make camp changes? *(cont'd.)*

Cancellations made less than 6 business days prior to the beginning of the camp session will result in the forfeiture of half the camp session fee per camper. No refunds will be granted after 5:00pm the Friday before the camp session begins. All camp change requests must be made in writing and are subject to a \$10 handling fee. ### Can my camper attend a Marinwood camp after a specialty camp ends?

Yes, this is an option for specialty camps located at Miller Creek Middle School that run from 9:00-12:00pm and if the Marinwood day camp has space or you are already enrolled in a Marinwood camp. The camper may attend Marinwood's camp from 12:00-3:00pm for the week of the specialty camp for a prorated amount. Camp staff will escort the camper to Marinwood's camp at noon. Campers must be enrolled in both Marinwood's camp and the specialty camp first, then email csd@marinwood.org for the prorated refund. The half day Marinwood camp fee will be \$185 for residents and \$218 for non-residents for the session. Session 4 will be \$158 for residents and \$187 for non-residents.



### Do campers need to wear masks or be vaccinated? Are the staff vaccinated?

Marinwood does not require campers or staff to be vaccinated, although it is strongly encouraged. Mask and other health requirements will be determined closer to summer and will follow the most up to date state and local guidelines. Please check our website for the most current information before your camp session.

#### Where and when can I pick up my camper's t-shirts?

Camp shirts will be available for pickup starting in May at the Community Center during business hours. For safety, campers are required to wear a Marinwood camp t-shirt daily. Campers will receive 2 shirts per summer with the option of purchasing additional camp shirts for \$9. Pick up camp shirts at the Marinwood Community Center. Marinwood highly recommends picking up camp shirts before the first day of camp.

#### What should my camper bring with them every day?

Campers should come wearing appropriate camp attire. A Marinwood camp shirt and closed toe shoes are mandatory. Campers should bring a labeled backpack containing a snack, lunch, water bottle, swimsuit, towel, and sunscreen. Please try and limit camper's belongings to one backpack/bag.

#### Are there any other requirements for campers to attend?

All campers must be potty trained. Parents/guardians will be required to sign a liability waiver before attending as well as other pertinent camp forms. All participants 3rd grade and younger must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at check-in each day. Campers are not allowed to attend if ill.

#### How does check-in and check-out work?

All participants 3rd grade and younger must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at check-in each day. Campers are not allowed to attend if ill. For more information, please read the Camp Parent Packet.

#### Check-in:

Campers must be checked in with their Camp Director. Check-in will take place from 9:00-9:20am.

#### Check-out:

Campers must be checked out with camp staff before leaving. Check-out will take place from 2:50-3:05pm. If your camper is not picked up by 3:05pm, they will be sent to After Care and you will be charged a drop-in fee of \$22.

#### Do you offer Before and/or After Care?

Yes, Before Care runs from 8:00-9:00am and After Care from 3:00-5:00pm for additional fees. Please see the Before and After Care page 36 for more information.

#### Can my child take swim lessons during the camp day?

Yes, you may enroll in group or private lessons during the camp day for an additional fee. Camp staff will escort campers to lessons that take place between 10:45am and 2:25pm and 3:30-5:00pm, (if enrolled in After Care). Parents are responsible for escorting campers to any swim lessons scheduled at 2:30pm or 3:00pm. Please visit swim lesson pages 45-46 for additional information.

#### How does swimming work at camp?

Parents must give permission for their camper to swim in the Marinwood main and tot pools. Camps Pine Cone and Miwok swim only in the tot pool. Camps Willow, Buckeye, Bumblebee, and Acorn have the option of tot pool or main pool. All other camps exclusively use the main pool. Campers must pass a swim test (uninterrupted swim of 25 yards) to be able to swim in the deep end and go down the water slides. Campers may be asked to retake the swim test for camp, even if they have previously passed in another setting.

#### Can I order lunch for my child?

Yes. Marinwood CSD has partnered with BOONLI to provide online lunch ordering. All lunches are provided by our local Marinwood Market. Lunch options include a hot entrée or market sandwich, 2 organic sides and a drink. You can choose how many days a week you want lunch provided. Orders must be submitted by 10:00am the Friday before the session begins. Order online through the Marinwood website. No late orders will be accepted. Please pack a morning snack, as lunch will not arrive until noon.

#### What if my child has a food allergy?

Our number one priority is the safety of your child. Camp staff take precautions and preventative measures to ensure the safety of all campers. ### **Lifeguard Training**

#### Ages 15+

American Red Cross Lifeguard Training is the course you need to become a certified lifeguard. Participants who successfully complete this course will become certified in Lifeguarding, CPR/ AED for Lifeguards and First Aid.

Taught in the Blended-Learning format, students will have the opportunity to complete the majority of the classroom work online at their own pace prior to the first in-person class. This allows for three days of intensive, skill focused, in-person sessions.

Prerequisites:

- Proof of completion of e-learning portion at or before the start of the first in-person session.
- Participants must be 15 years old by or on the last day of class.
- Participants must pass a three part pre-course swimming test administered on the first day of class:

 300 yard continuous swim (not timed)
 20 yard swim, retrieval of 10lb object from 7ft depth, swim with object 20 yards, exit pool at side (1:40 time limit).
 Tread water with legs only (2 minutes).

Please bring a lunch, towel, and appropriate clothing for quick transition between pool and classroom.

NOTE: Any lifeguard candidate from these classes that applies and is hired at the Marinwood Pool will be reimbursed the Lifeguard Class Fee, excluding materials/certification costs.






